

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: By enrolling in the CFFA certification program do I automatically become a member of the Farm Financial Association (FFA)?

A: Yes. While membership in the FFA is FREE, all candidates that enroll in the CFFA certification program will also receive FREE access to all the strategy implementation guides located in the “PRODUCT” section of FFA.ag website.

Q: Is there an annual CFFA certification renewal fee?

A: Yes. The certification renewal fee is \$300 per year.

Q: How do I pay my CFFA certification renewal fee?

A: The certification renewal fee is an annual fee and must be paid on-line each year to keep your certification active. If the certification renewal fee is not paid within 60 days, your CFFA certification will become inactive. If your certification is left inactive for more than one year, the annual CFFA continuing education requirements must be met and the CFFA tests must be re-taken and passed to reactivate your CFFA certification.

Q: What else is required to keep my CFFA certification active?

A: All CFFA Designees are required to complete 24 hours of CE credit per year and must adhere to the CFFA Code of Ethics to keep their CFFA Certification active.

Q: How many hours of CFFA CE credit do I need per year?

A: The CFFA CE credit requirement is 24 hours per year. The year runs from January 1st through December 31, beginning the year after you've passed the CFFA test.

Q: How do I record my CFFA CE credit hours?

A: You personally keep track of your CE records and make them available if requested under audit.
